PRESS RELEASE

The Fire & Emergency Service Training School at Mairang in West Khasi Hills, was inaugurated today by Shri. Metbah Lyngdoh, Hon'ble Speaker, Meghalaya Legislative Assembly in the presence of Shri. Lahkmen Rymbui, Hon'ble Home Minister, Shri. R. Chandranathan, IPS Director General of Police and other Government officials.

The inauguration programme began with the Welcome Address by Shri. R. Chandranathan, IPS Director General of Police, followed by Medal Presentations to officials of the Organisation who were awarded with Governor's Medal and demonstration of techniques adopted by F&ES Organisation in their endeavour to mitigate disasters. An exhibition of all the equipment available with F&ES Organisation was also displayed in the programme.

The Guest of Honour, Shri. Lahkmen Rymbui, Hon'ble Home Minister in his address lauded the Department for the initiatives taken to setup the Training School and also, briefly shared about the positive outcomes that will emerge from the Training School. The Chief Guest of the programme, Shri. Metbah Lyngdoh, Hon'ble Speaker, Meghalaya Legislative Assembly spoke at length about the requirement of setting up the F&ES Training School and different kinds of trainings that will be imparted in the future.

The campus along with infrastructures on which the Training School has been established, belonged to the General Administrative Department and the Office of the Executive Engineer PWD (Roads) Mairang, and the Department is grateful to both these offices for handing over the land with infrastructures for the purpose of setting up the Training School.

The Training School will be conducting Basic Elementary Fire Fighting Training as well as Cadre Courses for the new recruits and in-service officials of the Organisation and henceforth, all technical trainings will be imparted in this School.
