D. Medical Standard (Male/Female Candidate)

The candidates should be of sound health, free from defect/deformity/disease. Both eyes should have a vision 6/12 (without glasses) and no colour blindness. No relaxation is allowed to any category of candidates on this count.

V. TESTS:

A. PRELIMINARY MEDICAL TESTS (Qualifying): -

On the day of recruitment, candidates will be subjected to preliminary medical tests before they go for physical tests/written tests.

Only those who qualified in the preliminary medical tests will be allowed to appear in the physical tests.

B. **PHYSICAL TESTS (Qualifying)** – The following qualifying physical tests will be conducted :-

FOR MALE CANDIDATES

- 1.1500 metres Race to be completed in 7 minutes or less.
- 2. High Jump- Minimum height required to clear 4 feet.
- 3.Long Jump- Minimum distance required to clear 11 feet.

FOR FEMALE CANDIDATES

- 1.1500 metres Race to be completed in 9 minutes or less.
- 2. High Jump- Minimum height required to clear 3 feet.
- 3.Long Jump- Minimum distance required to clear 8 feet.

ALL CANDIDATES **SHOULD CLEAR/QUALIFY** THE ABOVE MINIMUM STANDARDS OF THE PHYSICAL TESTS BEFORE THEY ARE ALLOWED TO APPEAR AT THE WRITTEN TESTS.

Note: There shall be no appeal against disqualification in race, long jump, high jump.

C. **WRITTEN TESTS:** - Only those candidates, who qualify in the physical tests, will be allowed to appear in the written/subsequent tests as follows: -

(QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS SHALL BE IN ENGLISH LANGUAGE ONLY AND STANDARD WILL BE OF HSLC/SSLC (MATRIC) LEVEL)

1. GENERAL ENGLISH: 100 Marks of 1 hour 30 mins duration

2.GENERAL KNOWLEDGE: 50 Marks of 30 mins duration

3. ELEMENTARY MATHEMATICS/SCIENCE: 100 Marks of 1 hour duration

Full Marks = 250 Marks of 3 hours duration.

Note: - The paper in General English will also consist of Comprehension, Essay writing, Precis and drafting.

The other papers will have only objective type questions with multiple choice answers which the candidates will need to carefully tick only.

Candidates should not make any corrections once they have ticked the multichoice answers. Any corrections or overwriting made will render null and void the answer to that particular multichoice question.

D. PERSONAL INTERVIEW: - Full Marks = 50 marks

The Central Selection Board shall decide the number of candidates to be called for interview based on the total number of vacancies.

The result of the written test will be published on the 27th March 2012 and all candidates are advised to check the results on the notice boards of PTS/ District SPs Police Reserve Office/COs Battalions Office and on the Meghalaya Police website. Candidates who have qualified in the written tests will be required to attend the interviews which will be commence from the 2nd April 2012 onwards. It shall be the responsibility of the candidate(s) to check the results and appear for the interview at PTS,Golf Links, Shillong on the dates as notified.
