STATE HONOURS TO MARTYRS

Dated Shillong the 17th September 2012

A "Shok Parade" was held at 1st MLP Battalion, Mawiong, Shillong today (17th September 2012) at 4:30 PM to give State Honours to Late Constables Donnyboy Nongkhlaw and Jumbinon Mawlong who died while undergoing training at Mahidanda, Uttarakhand on 15th September 2012. Flower Wreaths were placed on the bodies by Honourable Chief Minister of Meghalaya Shri Mukul Sangma, Home Minister Shri HDR Lyngdoh, Urban Affairs Minister Smti. Ampareen Lyngdoh and Director General of Police, Meghalaya Shri N Ramachandran, IPS, besides lot of senior officers of all ranks of Meghalaya Police.

While commemorating the supreme sacrifice made by these brave constables in the course of duty, Honourable Chief Minister announced that as they have died while undergoing a very strenuous training to equip themselves to fight against the anti national elements, the State Government would provide them ex-gratia payments and other compensation at the same rates as is given in the case of Police personnel who die 'in action'.
