In view of the implementation of the Crime and Criminal Tracking Network and Systems (CCTNS) in the State and in order to ensure consistency and standardization across the country, it is hereby notified that the pattern of maintaining the General Diary (GD) as per Assam Police Manual Part V, rule No.53 is modified from the current monthly basis to a daily basis. In order to give effect to the change, the Assam Police Manual Pt V, rule No.53 clause (i) is hereby amended as follows:-

"Every entry made in the diary will be given a marginal heading in as few words as possible, and numbered in a DAILY series and attested by the signature of the officer in charge of a police station at the time. If it be proved that an officer in charge of police station had done any official act which he has not inserted and truly stated in his diary or that any occurrences have been willful omitted, or any willful false entry has been made he will be liable to punishment". The rule comes into force with effect from the first day the next month.
