2.	Representative of the National Commission for Schedule Caste and Safai Karamcharis	- Member Ex- Officio
3.	MLA of North Shillong Constituency & MLA of South Shillong Constituency.	- -do-
4.	The Director General of Police Meghalaya, Shillong	- -do- Ex-Officio
5.	Secretary, Home Police Department / Social Department	- -do-
6.	Chief Executive Officer of all the Municipal Boards and Cantonment Board.	- -do-
7.	Not more than four social worker belonging to organization working for the prohibition of manual scavengers representing the scavenger community to be nominated by the Govt. two of whom shall be women.	- -do-
8.	State Level head of the convener Bank of the State Level Bankers Committee.	- -do- Ex-Officio
9.	Principal Secretary/ Commissioner Secretary Urban Affairs Department.	- Member Secretary, Ex-Officio
10.	Representative of other department of the State Govt. and such other agencies in which in the opinion of the State Govt. are concerned with the implementation of this Act.	- Member

Term of Reference:-

- To monitor and advice the State Government and local authorities for effective implementation of the Act.
- To co-ordinate the functions of all concerned agencies.
- To look into any other matter incidental thereto or connected therewith for implementation of the Act.
