The Police Training School, Mawroh, Shillong is located adjacent to the most beautiful and famous Golf course of Shillong which is a tourist attraction and just 5 kms away from Shillong city.

The main aim of this training institute is to impart Basic training of newly recruited UB Constables and to conduct various promotion Cadre Courses and In-service courses of UB personnel and officers of various rank. It also organises awareness programme on various issues in collaboration with local NGOs Network, to sensitise force personnel for the larger Public interest.

## **BASIC TRAINING 2016**

**1. Basic Training Course of UB/RC:-** The newly recruited trainees have to undergo 9 months (270 days) basic training course mainly on Indoor and outdoor subjects. In Indoor subjects the Recruit Constables are imparted training on the Major Acts i.e.(IPC, CrPC and Indian Evidence Act), Minor Acts and Local laws as well as awareness programmes on Police Public Relation and Community Policing.

In outdoor subjects the trainees are trained in keeping physical fitness and maintenance of disciplinary conduct in the police force. They are also imparted training in handling of arms and lathi's with simulation exercises so as to maintain public order.

(i) Basic Training Course of 38th batch of UB/RCs:- The Basic training course of UB/RC of 38th Batch was conducted at Police Training School Shillong for a period of 9 (nine) months and 6(six) No's of UB/RCs consisting of 3(three) males and 3(three) females were imparted training in both Outdoor and Indoor subjects and accordingly they passed out from the training Institution on 20th May,2016. (ii) Basic Training of 39th batch of AB/UB RCs: - A total of 11(eleven) AB and UB/RCs are presently undergoing training at this institution consisting of 3(three) male and 2(two) female UB/RCs and 3(three) male and 3(three) female AB/RCs w.e.f.5th September 2016.



**2.Cadre course-I :-** Police Training School conducts Cadre course-I for promotion of UB constable to the rank of UB Head Constable for a period of 12 weeks and impart training on Indoor and Outdoor subject. The trainees who obtain pass marks in both outdoor and indoor subjects as prescribed will be eligible for next promotion.

**Cadre course-II (13.01.2016 to 10.05.2016):** - Police Training School also conducts Cadre course – II for the UB Head Constable for promotion to the rank of UB Sub Inspector for a period of 12 weeks, and imparted training in both Outdoor and Indoor subjects. The trainees who secured prescribed pass mark are eligible for the next promotion. A total of 79 UBHCs passed the Cadre Course-II for promotion to the rank of UBSI.

**3.In-service Courses conducted by PTS:** - Police Training School conducts various In-service courses of different ranks as per approved Meghalaya Training Calendar on various subjects. It also conducts various awareness programme on general issues in collaboration with local NGOs Network. The following are the In-service courses conducted by Police Training School during 2016.

(i) Course on Child Right and Protection of Children from Sexual Offence (POCSO) Act 2016 (7<sup>th</sup> – 9<sup>th</sup> March, 2016):-The above course is required to be conducted for the trainees from the level of Constable to Inspector to understand the importance of the law and to equip them while dealing with the child related cases in the thana level in the interest of Public Justice.

(ii) Course on Human Rights (14<sup>th</sup> – 16<sup>th</sup> March, 2016):-The course is conducted from the level of Sub-Inspectors to Inspectors for upholding the importance and dignity of human values by the law enforcing agencies.

(iii) Course on Community Policing (6<sup>th</sup> -8<sup>th</sup> April 2016):- As we are aware that India is a secular state having people from different types of communities. The course is important to conduct from the level of Constable to Inspector to understand the feeling of every caste, creed and religion while dealing with law firmly.

#### (iv) Course on Trafficking of women, children and Drugs (25th - 26th April, 2016) :-

Trafficking of women and children widely affects human society. Children from 15 years onwards are badly addicted to drugs which have become a threat to the civil society and challenging for the police force in dealing with such crimes and criminals. So as to combat such challenges police personnel from the rank of Constable to Inspector are imparted training to make them conversant with different laws related to this subject.

(v) Courses on Ethics in law Enforcement and Principles of Police Conduct (25<sup>th</sup> May, 2016):- This course is conducted from the level of Constables to Inspector to encourage the trainees to work ethically keeping in mind that their normal values, dignity are not hampered while dealing with public during law and order problem and investigation of cases and upholding the principles of Police conduct

(vi) Awareness Programme on HIV/AIDS (30<sup>th</sup> -31<sup>st</sup> May,2016) :- This course is conducted in collaboration with the Local NGO's Network from the level of Constable to Inspector. The Police personnel sometimes become victims of sexual exploitation at their work place. Hence to protect from such menace, awareness on HIV/AIDS programme are conducted for taking precautionary measure in their life.



(vii) MPDA/UAP Act (13th to 15 June 2016):- The process and procedural aspect of detention for the criminals under this Act is mandatory for the maintenance of Public order and justice for which officers and men are specially trained, with due care avoiding loop holes so that rights while framing charges against anti social elements or any insurgent groups.

(viii) Gender Sensitisation for Police Personnel (7<sup>th</sup> -8<sup>th</sup> July 2016) :- In civil society people are highly educated and qualified and with a view to upgrade the quality of policing, and image, police personnel are sensitized to deal with public firmly and politely so that rights and equality are restored when implementing rules of law.



(ix) Course on Investigation of Homicide/Suicide and Drowning Cases (21st -22nd July, 2016) :- This course is conducted for the officers investigating such cases, equiping them with the actual procedure and finding a fact for the cause of death of a victim

(x) Course on Departmental Proceeding (25<sup>th</sup> - 27<sup>th</sup> July,2016) :- Judicial Proceeding and departmental proceedings are two different aspects of dealing with accused and delinquency. As such departmental employees are dealt with as per the code of conduct of the concerned department following the procedure of Disciplinary and Appeal rules. This course teaches officers on how to conduct Departmental Enquiries and Proceedings.



(xi) One day workshop on Disaster Management (22<sup>nd</sup> Aug 2016) :- The Police personnel are specially trained as to how to overcome and help people at the time of disaster that occurs suddenly like earthquake, flood, etc



(xii) Providing Timely Help To Victim of Road Accident (31<sup>st</sup> Aug 2016):- This course has become mandatory for the Police personnel on duty to take action and help the victims to get immediate first aid and medical treatment without further delay.



(xiii) Course on Investigation and Prosecution of Cases (17th -19th Oct, 2016):- This course is conducted from the level of UBSI to UB inspector, it has been periodically observed that there is lack of proper investigation of various cases where Procedures pertaining to the investigation are not followed, resulting in cases which end in FR. Thus accused are not timely prosecuted and the conviction rate become very low. To overcome from procedural lapses, the officers are trained with practical classes and proper utilization of various sections of IPC.

#### 4. Course Conducted by other Unit/ Organisation

#### (a) 2 (Two) days Course on Scientific Aids to Investigation by FSL (29<sup>th</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup> August, 2016).

This course is mainly conducted for the Investigation Officers on FSL matters. The Officers are imparted training on the importance of scientific aids pertaining to the investigation and to take due care while sending the exhibit to the FSL etc.



#### (b) 21 (Twenty one) days Proficiency course in finger Print Science by CID (11.4.2016 - 02.5.2016)

The CID organization conducted a 21 (Twenty one) days Proficiency Course in finger Print Science at PTS. The trainees are imparted training on lifting and preservation of finger Print from the place of occurrence, and acquaint them with its importance of evidential value while dealing with the case.

#### (c) Refresher Course for SWAT personnel by SF-10 (25th July – 10th September, 2016):-

SWAT personnel who were inducted to the SF-10 underwent a 6 (six) days refresher course specially designed for them at PTS. These SWAT personnel had undergone Basic and specialized Commando courses in 2010-2012, but for the last few years they have been operating all over the state carrying out operations against militants relentlessly and without any refresher course. The aim of the course was to provide adequate rest, recuperation, de-stressing, skill enhancement and assimilation through interactions with SF-10 Commandos. There were 6 batches consisting a total of 164 Commandos who attended the course.



(d) 2 (Two) days Training Course of Police Officers on Non- Banking Financial Companies/ Un-incorporated Bodies and Micro Finance institutions (NBFCS/UIBS/MFIS) by CID (7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> September, 2016) This Course is conducted for Police Officers who deals with the Bank Fraud cases with the resource persons from Reserve Bank of India, Security Exchange Board of India and Enforcement Directorate.
