## <u>CIRCU</u>LAR NO. 5/2016

Matter has been brought to my notice that some District Superintendents of Police have issued instructions not to issue POL/DOL to the vehicles of other Districts & Units when they come on duty to their districts. The common reason cited for not issuing POL/DOL to the vehicles of other districts is huge outstanding dues of POL/DOL to suppliers. Due to various reasons, such as late receipt of LOA and inadequacy of Budget Provisions under POL/DOL, sometimes the outstanding dues tend to reach a point where the suppliers, with prior notice, stop supplying POL/DOL to departmental vehicles. Such situation of non-payment does not last over a month or so on an average. However, after LOA is released to the District SPs, the supply resumes.

All the Districts SPs and Commandants of other Units are hereby instructed not to stop issuing POL/DOL to the vehicles of other districts and Units which come to their districts on duty, except under the circumstances when the supply of POL/DOL is stopped by the suppliers on ground of overdues, then District SPs and heads of Units should issue prior notice by WT to other Districts/Units regarding temporary stoppage of POL/DOL by suppliers. Such notice should be withdrawn immediately on release of payment. It is emphasized that no sooner the supplier resumes issuing POL/DOL, then the POL/DOL should be issued to vehicles of other Districts/Units.

As has been the practice, the POL/DOL bills should be sent promptly to the erned SPs / Unit heads for payment.
