Subject : LAWS RELATING TO WOMEN AND CHILDREN.

In view of the fact that various crimes against women and children are on the increase, it is a professional requirement that the Police officers at the cutting edge level deployed at PS/OP level, should know which law and sections of law are in the force, which shall be applied to give correct direction to the investigation of the cases and bring the perpetrators of crime to expeditious justice.

Superintendents of Police are instructed to regularly brief the officers and men during thana visit, crime conference and periodic inspections of the PS/OPs.
