DGPs CIRCULAR NO. 2/2015

In partial modification of the Circular No. 27/2010, dt. 06.06.2010, the

following amendment is hereby issued with a view to make the procedures clear in the

matter of promotion of Un-Armed Branch / Armed Branch Sub-Inspector

(UBSI/ABSI) to Un-Armed Branch / Armed Branch Inspector (UBI/ABI.

1. It is re-iterated that the promotion of UBSI/ABSI to the rank of UBI/ABI will

be based on seniority-cum-merit and not on the basis of merit as stated in the

aforesaid mentioned departmental circular.

2. The cut-off marks in the Promotion Board for a candidate to be eligible for

promotion is fixed at 40% of the total of 100 marks that have been laid down in

the said departmental circular. Promotion is subject to availability of vacancies.

3. A candidate who does not score 40% of the marks in the Board will be

considered only in the next two succeeding Promotion Boards.

This amendment comes into immediate effect.
