CIRCULAR NO. 2/2025

Government of Meghalaya vide Notification No. HPL.54/2010/118 dated 18th April, 2016, established a dedicated Cyber Crime Police Station (CCPS) under CID with state-wide jurisdiction of Meghalaya for investigation of Cyber and Internet related crimes.

Whereas, the investigation of cybercrime cases shall ordinarily be conducted by Police Stations of various districts where the victim is an ordinary resident, certain category of cases which require specialize investigation will be conducted by Cyber Crime Police Station.

In view of the growing offences of cybercrimes in the state, the Cyber Crime Police Station will take up investigation for the following category of cases:

1. Cases to be Handled by CCPS:

- **Cybercrimes of National/Regional Importance:** Those impacting the sovereignty, integrity, and security of India or State of Meghalaya.
- **High-Value Cybercrimes:** Cases involving amounts equal to or exceeding ₹50 lakhs.
- **Public Importance with Wider Impact:** Cases that effect multiple districts or inter-state ramifications.
- Any other case directed for investigation by the Director General of Police.

2. Transfer Process of Cases from Police Station to Meghalaya CCPS:

- **Step 1:** The Superintendent of Police will submit a detailed report about the nature of the cybercrime and the amount involved to the Deputy Inspector General (DIG) of the respective range.
- **Step 2:** The DIG, upon reviewing the report and deeming the case fit for specialized investigation, will forward the case with a recommendation for transfer to the Director General of Police.
- **Step 3:** The Director General of Police will decide on the transfer based on the recommendation of the DIGs of the Ranges.

3. Final Authority:

- The decision regarding the investigation of cybercrime cases by the Cyber Crime Police Station is final and rests with the Director General of Police, Meghalaya.

This Circular will supersede all previous circular on this matter.
