Minutes of the meeting on CCTNS project held under the chairmanship of IGP (CID) on 28/10/2013 in his chamber, Police HQ, Meghalaya

Agenda

IGP (CID) welcomed all to the meeting and said that Shri. D.N Jyrwa, Superintendent of Police is on tour of districts w.e.f 28/10/2013 to assess the project implementation of CCTNS at Police Station and higher offices.

Discussion/Decisions

- 1. IGP (CID) informed that he sent queries to SPMU in connection with connectivity already provided at 53 sites. A report was submitted by SPMU, but IGP (CID) said that the report is not satisfactory as per his queries, which were as follows.
- a) The connectivity status at Khanapara and Sohra Police Stations: These two links were found faulty when personally checked by IGP (CID).
- b) Whether the connectivity is actually working at whichever sites they have been shown 'OK'.
- c) The status of sites where VSAT is to be provided.
- d) Concerned OCs of Police Stations where connectivity has been provided be instructed to work on CCTNS System and the OCs can be provided with requisite training materials, 'online'.

SPMU assured that needful actions will be taken to solve the above issues raised by IGP (CID)

- 2. IGP (CID) wanted to know about today's (28.10.2013) inspection to be carried out by a team where Superintendent of Police, SCRB comprising SI and SPMU and representative of state. SPMU informed that inspection on connectivity is in progress at the following locations
 - (i) Jowai PHQ, Jowai Circle Office, Jowai DTC, Jowai P.S & Jowai DPCR
 - (ii) Amlarem P.S, Amlarem Circle office & Amlarm SDPO.

As directed by IGP (CID) in the meeting, inspecting team has to be instructed to find out whether all system hardware and connectivity are working at the Police Station.

- 3. Regarding SWAN connectivity, Insp. A Sangma informed the meeting that Shri Nayan Moni Sharma, Project Manager of SWAN has informed SPMU that equipment for 24 sites was received and work would start soon. IGP (CID) instructed Insp. A Sangma has to visit SWAN office to get the latest status of the SWAN connectivity.
- 4. IGP (CID) enquired about the status of the Citizen portal and instructed that SP/Shillong & SP/Tura should be instructed to do the needful in conducting the test of the Citizen portal. The feedback provided by Superintendent of Police, East Khasi Hills on Citizen Portal does not relate to CCTNS Project Citizen Portal. It was decided that Superintendent of Police, East Khasi Hills be requested again to conduct the Citizen Portal Test with user as per the requirement of the CCTNS Project. As regards, West Garo Hills District, no feedback has been received. Superintendent of Police, West Garo Hills will be reminded for this.

5. IGP (CID) instructed Insp. A. Sangma to forward the report received from the NCRB regarding workshop held on 17.10.2013 at New Delhi to SI for taking required actions from their end. Insp. A Sangma was also asked to approach the Home Department officers for the minutes of the last State Apex Committee meeting held under the chairmanship of Chief Secretary as the copy of the same has not been received in this office.
